### What to do in an emergency situation

1. Call 000 in the event of an emergency
2. Action emergency plan
3. Await advice from authorities
4. Listen to your local ABC radio station for updates ([www.abc.net.au](http://www.abc.net.au))
5. Monitor the SES website - <http://australia.gov.au/topics/family-home-and-community/emergency-services/ses-state-emergency-services>
6. Tune into **Watch and Act**; radio, apps, website, TV
7. Monitor the BOM; weather and warnings; <http://www.bom.gov.au/qld/flood/index.shtml>
8. Follow the Hart Hill Camping's Facebook Page;

9. Download the Southern Downs Regional Council App to be informed of weather events and road closures <https://www.sdrc.qld.gov.au/payments---services/my-sdrc-app> or view <http://disasterdashboard.sdrc.qld.gov.au/> for local updates
10. Organise a personal safety kit;
  - long sleeve shirt, jeans, boots,
  - medications and bottled water
  - battery operated radio, phone and charger, torch and batteries
  - identification documents and valuables; photos etc.
  - First aid kit.

# Emergency Procedure for Campers

## Fire and Flood

---

### Campers are to prepare for an emergency by;

- Turning of all gas bottles and other flammable hazards
- Turning off electric appliances etc.
- Containing pets (dog cages are available at Hart Hill Camping)
- Supervising children closely
- Closing windows and doors of caravans, cars etc.
- Bringing all door mats inside
- Relocating to the appropriate Emergency Area
- Ensure they have their own transport at Hart Hill Camping in order to evacuate if necessary.

### Management of Hart Hill Camping will:

- Place signs at the registration office, notifying campers of the need to sign in and out of the guest register to account for all in the case of an evacuation
- Contact anticipated guests prior to advise of imminent flood or fire
- Closely monitor flood and fire warnings and threats and communicate such to campers
- Request additional information from guests; age, medication, health conditions, disabilities, etc.
- Upon consideration of an emergency threat, management reserves the right to postpone any planned events/camping.

## BUSHFIRE

In case of a Bushfire Emergency at Hart Hill Camping or in a rural environment, it is advised that you consider packing your own **Bushfire Emergency Kit**;

- Personal safety kit (including the above)
  - long sleeve shirt, jeans, boots, hat,
  - safety goggles, smoke masks, leather gloves
- Towels and blankets – cotton or wool
- Mops, bucket and hose.

### Total Fire Ban Days

### On Total Fire Ban days:

- Open fires will be prohibited – gas and electric barbeques are acceptable
- A Fire Danger Warning sign will be updated as necessary.

### Extreme and Catastrophic Fire Days

On days declared as a catastrophic fire event, **all camping at Hart Hill will be postponed** and only existing guests will be expected to evacuate (if safe to do so). In most instances, there should be some warning of an impending catastrophic fire day.



